Open Afternoon

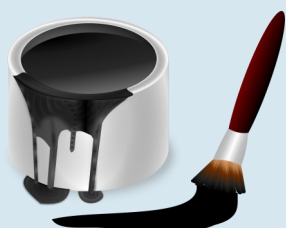
